## About the Residential and Commercial Property Management Program

The Residential and Commercial Property Management Bachelor of Applied Science (RCPM BAS) program prepares students for a residential or commercial property management career. It is a multi-disciplinary curriculum combining business, accounting, and real estate courses.

North's Property Management BAS is the only property management bachelor's degree in the Pacific Northwest that offers a unique hands-on program that prepares students to immediately work in the dynamic commercial and residential landscape. The RCPM BAS program will prepare graduates for careers in property management with current median earnings of over **\$81,000 per year** in Seattle.

The Property Management bachelor's degree program now has all online and evening Zoom classes, allowing students to complete this program from anywhere. Students can use past college credits to finish their Property Management bachelor's degree within two years.

The property management BAS program utilizes property management professionals and firms to create and update the program curriculum. The program thus ensures that graduates have the skills and knowledge to succeed in a rapidly growing and changing built environment.
